Private Work

We understand that everyone is struggling financially and appreciates the opportunity for additional work especially with the cost of living increasing. From time to time, clients may ask you, as a care worker to do work privately for them. Out of respect for your employer (us), we would apprecaite being told rather than finding out from the client and/or another staff member. Its important to consider the following legal requirments, when accepting private work:

- ❖ Safeguarding yourself and the client do not put your client and/or yourself at risk; if the client requires 2:1 for moving & handling, please do not put yourself in a situation where you are putting yourself and/or the client in a dangerous situation. Ensure you risk assess.
- Gaining own carer insurance
- * Registering for self employment Register for Self Assessment: Register if you're self-employed GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) to avoid tax evasion.
- ❖ Keeping up to date with your own training.
- Putting your DBS on the update service; <u>DBS</u>
